

Patchwork Hub's Summer Internship Scheme is an award-winning programme of internships and employment opportunities for disabled students. Put simply, we find, recruit and onboard exceptional disabled interns for your business from across the UK's leading universities.

We work with our partners to provide accessible paid positions for our skilled, disabled talent pool. We build relationships with our applicants, whom we support throughout their placements.

The service includes:

- An accessible and inclusive job description: understanding your company and requirements.
- Inclusive Recruitment Campaign with universities: we design, manage and administer the entire recruitment campaign on your behalf.
- Onboarding support for both candidate and employer: facilitating the adjustments process, with a bespoke accessibility assessment and bespoke intern briefing with the candidate's line manager.
- Ongoing support as and when required throughout the placement.




About our founder

Healthier Working Lives Commission and co-founded the Disabled Entrepreneurs Network.
